Outstanding A4 Color Printer for Small Workgroups

Much like its MFP sibling and fellow Pick winner, the Ricoh SP C252SF, the unit offers a cost of ownership that's roughly 34 percent lower than the average of tested devices in this class.

But that's not the end of that discussion. Standard 1:2 automatic duplexing and toner-save mode can contribute to an even lower cost of ownership and, of course, speak to the eco friendliness of the 21-ppm color laser printer. And via Ricoh Web Image Monitor, the embedded web server, administrators have the power to restrict access to color usage in an effort to further conserve resources and save money. "The bottom line is that high-volume users can save approximately \$4,700 versus the competition, over 36 months," Schell said.

A standard wireless connection, combined with the Ricoh Smart Device Print&Scan app (available for iOS and Android), means users can quickly and easily print multiple types of documents from mobile devices, including those stored in the cloud, using sites such as Dropbox and Google Drive. For modern businesses that have adopted a BYOD policy, the flexibility afforded by mobile print support can help boost productivity.

Productivity is buoyed by the unit's strong ease of use, too. At the desktop, users can save settings for frequently used jobs in the PCL driver, thus allowing for oneclick programming, while navigating the menu system on the LCD is straightforward. Flawless durability and simple routine maintenance procedures will keep downtime to a minimum.
